This new crop of high-complication timepieces embodies the alpha male ideal, their heart-fluttering façades only rivaled by the sophisticated mechanisms within. **Audemars Piguet's Royal Oak Skeleton** features an openworked movement noted for its clean, modern lines, while **Hublot's Big Bang Tourbillon Vendôme** boasts replicas of Place Vendôme's iconic column on each side of its tourbillon cage. **Ulysse Nardin's** inventive **Freak Diavolo** enlists a flying tourbillon to indicate the seconds. **Piaget's Emperor Coussin Tourbillon Automatic** is the thinnest watch of its kind at 10.4mm, while **Urwerk's UR-110** is designed to be easily read from beneath a sleeve. And for those who like to keep things under wraps, **Bulgari's Octo Quadri-Retro Chronograph** bears a movement concealed under a graphic dial displaying four retrograde functions. After all, a little mystery is part of the alpha allure! **▲**
