A fine watch is more than a mere accessory. Merging artistry with engineering, watchmakers deliver real-world functionality in timepieces that also express your personal style. | *By Laurie Kable* |

THE CONSUMMATE COLLECTOR

If you're a true connoisseur, these exceedingly rare, highly complex timepieces will prove too tempting to resist.



▲ **A. Lange & Söhne's** Richard Lange Tourbillon Pour le Mérite (\$185,300) takes inspiration from an antique pocket watch with sub-dials for hours, minutes and seconds. Sneak an unimpeded look at the spinning tourbillon when the segmented hour dial retracts. At Chong Hing Jewelers

▼ **Vacheron Constantin's** Patrimony Contemporaine Perpetual Calendar (\$73,100) marks the classical family's first perpetual calendar, which adjusts for months of varying lengths as well as leap years without correction until March 1, 2100. At Westime, Beverly Hills



▼ **Patek Philippe's** Ladies First Split Seconds Chronograph Ref. 7059R (\$490,000) showcases a sprinkling of flawless diamonds on the bezel and houses a highly complex, manually wound column-wheel movement. At Tiffany & Co., Beverly Hills



▲ **Piaget's** Emperor Coussin Tourbillon Automatic Ultra-Thin (price upon request) claims the record for the world's slimmest self-winding tourbillon, with a svelte case measuring 10.4 mm thick, drawing on Piaget's 50-year legacy in ultrathin mechanical movements. At David Orgell, Beverly Hills



▶ **Audemars Piguet's** Millenary 4101 (\$24,100) was designed and built to show off its inner workings on the dial side rather than through the case back. Its multilevel Calibre 4101 movement is on full view under time displays that appear to float within the oval case. At Westime, Beverly Hills



THE REBEL

If you're loving life as an unconventional free spirit who resists the status quo, these radical watches will satisfy your craving for creative expression.



▶ **Ulysse Nardin's** Freak Diavolo (\$153,500) is the latest evolution of the brand's iconoclastic Freak, which has no true dial, crown or hands. The tourbillon carousel movement indicates the time as it completes a full revolution every 60 minutes. At Feldmar Watch Company

▶ **Bell & Ross' BR 01** Red Radar (\$6,100) displays the time with a red-tinted radar screen constructed from three concentric discs, indicating hours (outer ring), minutes (middle ring) and seconds (inner ring). At Westime, Beverly Hills



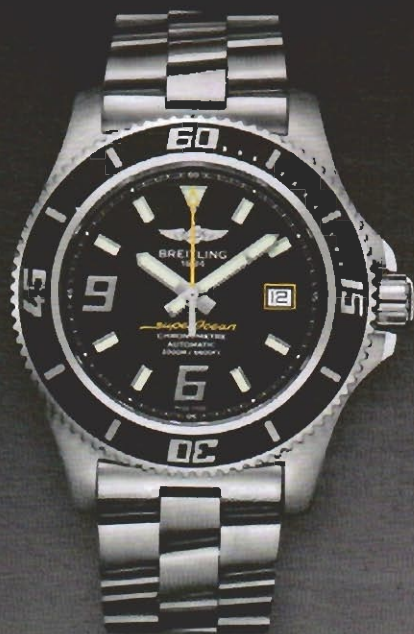
▶ **Parmigiani's** Bugatti Super Sport (\$285,000 for first edition of 30 pieces) carries on the revolutionary spirit of the original 2004 Bugatti watch by positioning the mechanical components of the new Calibre Bugatti PF 372 on a vertical axis, while displaying the time laterally for drivers. At Hours Minutes Seconds, Beverly Hills



▶ **Richard Mille's** RM033 Extra Flat Automatic (\$80,000) adapts Mille's signature, futuristic aesthetic to a thin, round titanium case. With its skeletonized movement, the RM033 not only looks technical, it boasts advanced features to heighten performance. At Richard Mille, Beverly Hills

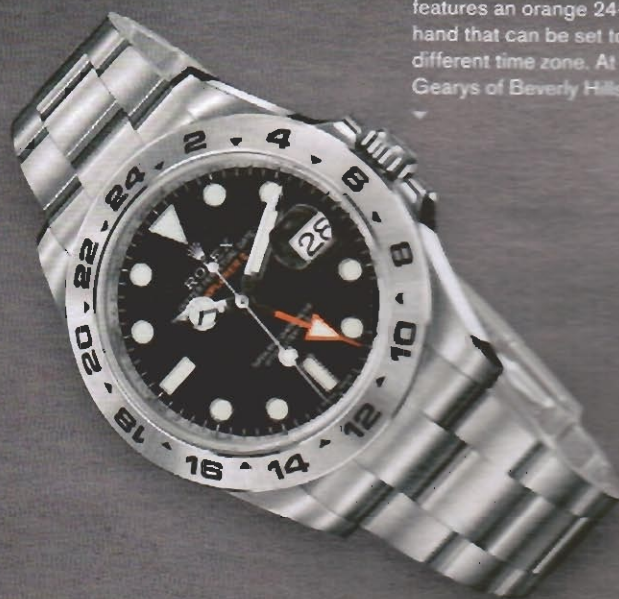
THE ADVENTURER

Whether you're flying high, diving deep or raising a sail, you'll be ready for action with these rugged watches outfitted for outdoor performance.



◀ **Breitling's** Superocean 44 (\$3,890), slightly up-sized and redesigned, stays watertight down to 2,000 meters (about 6,600 feet), even if you can't. At Westime, Beverly Hills

Rolex's Oyster Perpetual Explorer II (\$7,750) has been amped up to 42 mm and equipped with a new in-house movement and features an orange 24-hour hand that can be set to a different time zone. At Gearys of Beverly Hills



◀ Panera's Luminor Daylight (\$3,500) has undergone a makeover since its 1955 debut. Sylvester Stallone's in the movie Daylight. The sportier incarnation features a special case of extra Super-Luminova that imparts a soft glow after dark. At Offshore Panera, Beverly Hills



▲ **TAG Heuer's** Formula 1 Lady Steel and Ceramic Chronograph (\$1,900) combines durable materials with fashionable flair in four slick new 41 mm models for women on the go. At Tourneau, Century City

▶ **Corum's** Admiral's Cup Seafender 48 Chrono Centro in grade 5 titanium (\$9,600) breaks the rules by positioning the chronograph minute and second hands on the same axis as the central hour and minute hands, dispensing with conventional counters for a sleeker dial.
